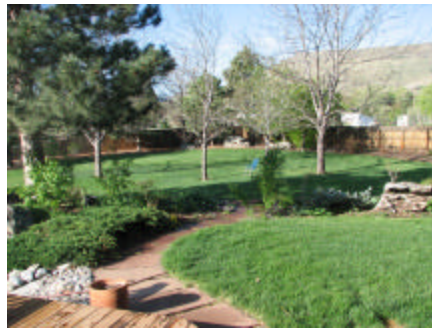

## CRAB GRASS INVASION !



It was like it came from nowhere. What started out like a regular spring lead to the worst crabgrass invasion across the metro area that any turf care professional can recall. We have conferred with our suppliers

that it must have been due to the lack of winter and spring moisture. In turn, this stressed and thinned out the blue grass and opened up space in the lawn for the crab to germinate and grow. Areas near concrete are the worse. All forms of pre-

emergent herbicides were ineffective, most likely because they weren't watered in properly and no rain or snow fell to wash the product to soil. Next spring it's critical to water after we apply the crabgrass control. And then hope for the best...

After yanking the junipers and establishing the outlines for the new beds, new deciduous and evergreen shrubs were selected that will tolerate shade as well as provide year round color.
