### trees **GOT WATER?**

Same old story, just another year. The front range is way behind on snow fall and, as such, the soil is drying out fast. These 60 and 70 degree days in January and February, along with the huge winds have parched the soil. Watering now can help reduce or eliminate winter damage that is noticed in the spring. It's time to drag out the hose and start watering on the sunny days!

- **Winter Grass Mite Control**

A dry winter is the perfect condition for grass mites to damage your lawn. Turf mites are nothing to mess with. They will kill off the lawn! Be proactive and sign up for our winter turf mite protection program. Prices start at \$50.00 per application depending on the size of lawn.

Watering the lawn in the winter on sunny days helps reduce the stress and desiccation that attract mites. South and west facing slopes in the lawn are critical areas to winter water. A good soaking should last 2 or 3 weeks.

- **Now is the time to Trim Trees!**

Dormant season pruning is our favorite time to trim trees! The entire structure of the tree is visible with nothing hidden behind foliage. One question that is frequently asked is how can we know what is dead when all the leaves are off? To the trained eye dead limbs are easy to spot. Shrunken and missing bark, no buds and no flexibility all indicate dead wood. When you have been caring for trees for as long as we have spotting dead wood is second nature. We also guarantee that if we miss any dead wood 1" diameter or larger that shows up in the spring we will return to prune it out at no charge.
